The Success By 6® Early Childhood Leadership Award is given to a Lancaster County person who through her/his leadership has made a significant contribution to enhancing the quality of care for young children by means of advocacy, professional development, mentoring and/or other means of leadership.

The Success By 6® Early Care and Education Center Award is given to a Keystone STARS Child Care Center that has made great strides in improving and/or maintaining the quality of care during the past year and advocates for children and their families.

The Success By 6® Child Care Provider Award is given to a state-regulated, quality Family or Group Child Care Home that has made great strides in improving and/or maintaining the quality of care during the past 2 years and advocates for children and their families.

The Carol D. Hess Children's Champion Award is given to a Lancaster County employer who has responded to the needs of their employees regarding children and child care.
