The GateHouse: GateHouse is looking to increase the use of technology by developing an internal computer lab at Marietta. Case Managers would work closely with clients setting them up with computers to assist with resume building, on-line classes such as certification, college, or GED classes, and skill building programs to include Adult and Child CPR training, Naxolone training, basic computer training to include typing, and financial workshops.



Milagro House and Clare House: Our proposal to Women United is for funding that supports: 1) the implementation of a newly created strategic alliance between Milagro House and Clare House that will remove our current siloed approach to post-program services and 2) leverages existing core strengths within each organization – including education and workforce development – to prepare and empower women to create sustainable futures for themselves and their children.

The objective of the 2022-2023 grant will be to better the lives of Lancaster County women over the age of 18 by promoting women’s financial stability.
