Decrease individuals and families living in poverty by 50%.

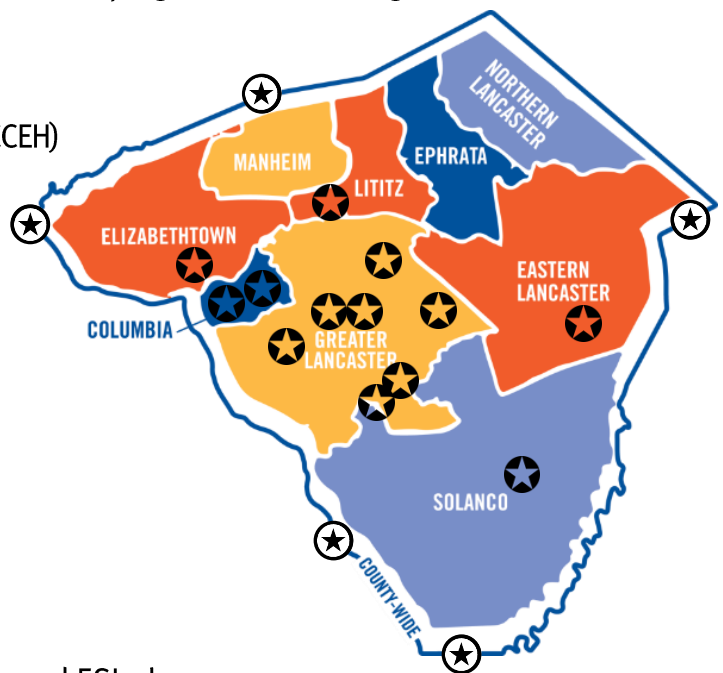


THE NEED: Financial Stability Statistics

YEAR 1 2015-2016 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Provided 400 new arrivals with language acquisition and ESL classes
- Expanded healthy food distribution program for young children
- Expanded accessibility to social services by creating access hubs in Pequea Valley, Solanco, and Elizabethtown
- Created a streamlined, single joint funding application for organizations serving people experiencing homelessness
- Enrolled new patients in co-pay assistance program, which helps patients afford medical visit co-pays
- Shifted from crisis management to empowering survivors to attain skills and resources to become self-sufficient
- Created community resource guide for individuals and families in Solanco
- Developed referral and consent process for families involved with Children & Youth to be connected to needed social services
- Increased VITA services by 23%
