Joint Funding

\$250,000:\$1,000,000

United Way invested \$250,000 which housing stability across Lancaster County which unlocked a 3:1 match through HUD creating a total of \$1 million in funding housing initiatives

\$60,000 invested to 4 nonprofit partners. Helping prevent summer learning loss.

Over \$102,00 in tuition assistance awarded, 37 children at 9 early leaning centers
