## UNITING EFFORTS FOR EFFICIENCY AND IMPACT

For almost 100 years, United Way of Lancaster County has focused on improving the education, financial stability and health of our County's residents. ## RESPONDING TO COMMUNITY NEEDS WITH FLEXIBILITY AND INNOVATION

In 2022 we introduced the Level Up & Launch initiative with nine local nonprofits benefiting from \$500,000 in United Way funds and matching funds to support kindergarten readiness, STEM and summer learning experiences for youth, mobile healthcare, economic mobility for new Americans, and equity curriculum to develop volunteers from under-served populations.

Specialists in 211 assist people with eviction prevention, food access, and many other resources available from hundreds of agencies in the region.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance in Lancaster is committed to providing free, high quality tax preparation to individuals and families making \$70,000 or less, helping them save and reducing the anxiety of tax time. In 2023, we helped almost 9,000 Lancaster County families file their taxes for free, saving them more than \$2 million in tax preparation fees.
